Notes to parents: Justice Page Middle School will continue using the streamlined system of organization for students and school materials using one binder with one section for each class. Students are required to have one three-ring binder with a pencil pouch, their planner, and pocket dividers. Donations are always welcome, especially binders.

During the first week of school, binders will be set up to create sections for each class. Teachers will communicate with students as to what should be in their section of the binder; most will have handouts and loose leaf paper (or notebook; see list above).

Our goals are to 1) have a uniform system, supported through Crew (Advisory), to teach organization; 2) reduce the need for trips to lockers for forgotten materials; and 3) simplify the required list of supplies necessary for school.
