## **All students please bring the following to class each day:**

- Zippered 3 ring binder (3" or 3-1/2") with strap
- Colored markers, 8-12 (*NO Sharpies*)
- Earbuds/headphones *with microphone*
- Erasers
- Highlighters
- Pencil pouch
- Pencil sharpener
- Pocket dividers (pack of 8)
- 6 folders
- 6 single subject notebooks (70 pages). for math, science, social studies, ELA and certain electives
- Sharpened pencils
- Calculator (For 6th/7th grade math, Texas Instruments TI-30XS preferred)
- Athletic shoes for Physical Education
- Hennepin County Library Card

## **Community Supplies (give to your crew leader)**

- Glue Sticks (1 pack of 2)
- Index cards (1 pk of 100)
- Sharpened pencils (4 packs of 24)
- Facial Tissue (5 boxes)
- Single subject notebooks 70 pgs (Qty. 3)
- Disinfectant Wipes (2 canisters)

## **Art/Murals students**

- 1 pocket folder that isn't shiny
- Ream of 8.5 x 11 white cardstock
- Medium 9x12 sketch pad, 25+pages (blank-no lines)

## **8<sup>th</sup> grade (In addition to the above bring these as well)**

- Colored pencils (for Global Studies)
- Geometry students: protractor & a beam/drawing compass (*not navigating compass*).
- Loose leaf graph paper (2 packs for math)

**Note to caregivers:** JPMS uses a streamlined system of organization for students using a single binder with 1 section for each class. Students are required to have one zippered three ring binder with a pencil pouch, planner & pocket dividers.

During their first week of school, student binders will be set up to create sections for each class. Teachers will communicate with students as to what should be in their section of the binder; most will each need a pocket for handouts and loose-leaf, lined paper or a notebook.

Our goal is to have a unified system supported through Crew/Advisory to:

1) teach organization; 2) reduce the need for trips to lockers for forgotten materials; and 3) simplify the required list of school supplies. Donations are always welcome!
