IN ATTENDANCE: Erin Rathke, Stephanie Shockley, Alison Constant, Dave Wingartner and Michelle Peters

BUDGETS – Sites will be getting their budgets on approximately 2/14 and we will have 3 weeks to tie out our budget. Our budget student count for the upcoming year is down from this year. Last year our numbers for this year were predicted at 816 and the preliminary figure for next year is 790. It was discussed that the 5th grade classes are smaller this year than last.

COMPREHENSIVE DESIGN – There are 4 possible models for the new Comprehensive Design:

1. The current model with some schools closing.
2. Community schools centralized.
3. Community Magnet schools.
4. Community Schools, some K-8 and some K-6

Erin does not anticipate enrollment or demographic changes for Justice Page with the Comprehensive Design.

There will be a Comprehensive Design listening session at Justice Page on Monday 2/3 at 6:30 in the auditorium and a discussion ensued about possible outcomes from that.
